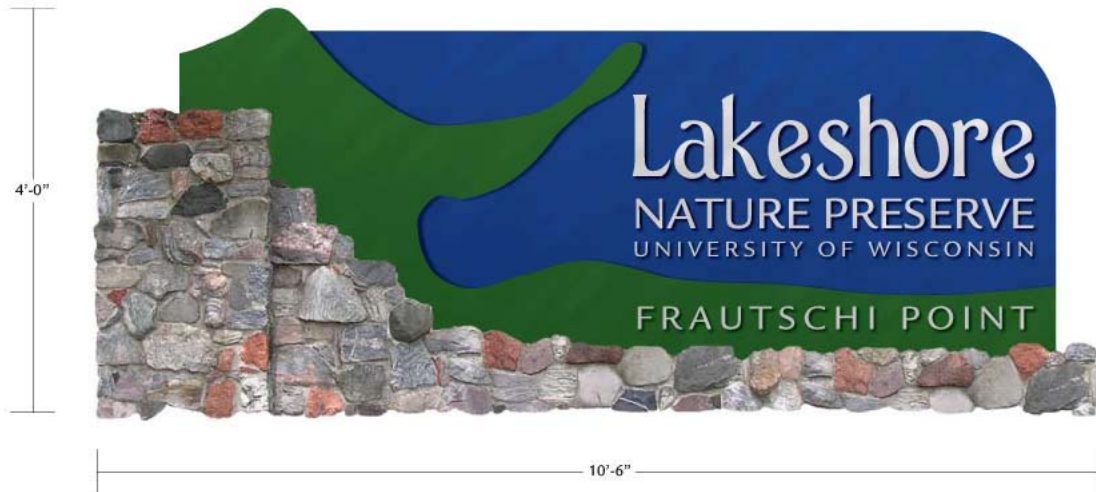
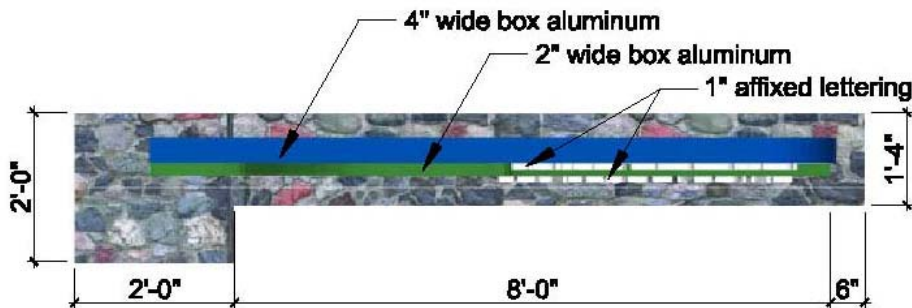

signs.

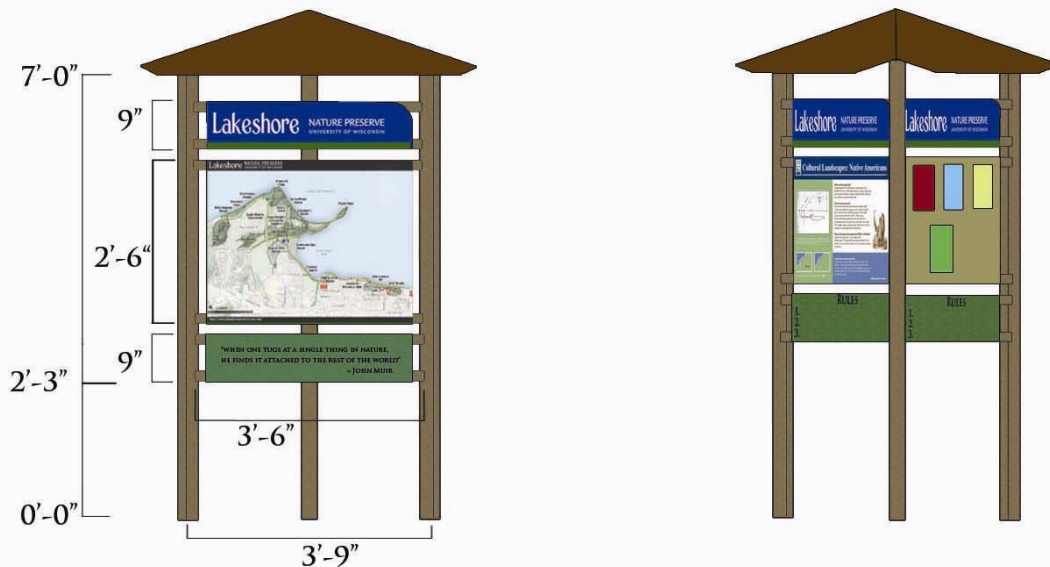
Small Scale Gateway Sign:



Located on Lake Mendota Drive, at the entrance to Raymer's Cove.

Materials to be black locust posts and professionally printed graphic sign faces laminated with lexan on a sturdy substrate.

Informational Kiosk:



Located at Frautschi Point Parking Lot, Picnic Point, East of the base of Muir Woods steps, other potential locations could be Raymer's Cove parking lot and the boat launch.

Materials to be black locust posts and professionally printed graphic sign faces laminated with lexan on a sturdy substrate.

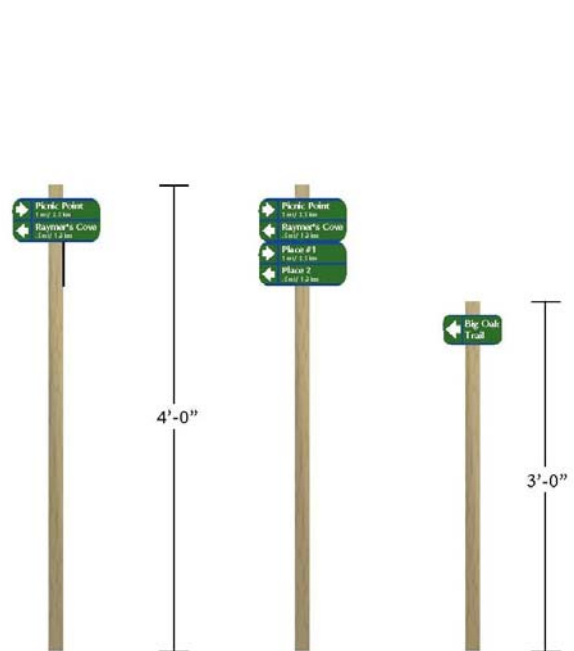
Trail Head Signs:



Located at areas where visitors are walking into the Preserve. See map for locations.

Materials to be black locust posts and professionally printed graphic sign faces laminated with lexan on a sturdy substrate.

Directional Signs:



Located as needed along the trails.

Materials to be 2" x 2" black locust posts, with vinyl or professionally printed and laminated with lexan.

Interpretive Signs:



Locations and text to be determined.

Materials to be black locust posts and professionally printed graphic sign faces laminated with lexan on a sturdy substrate.

Next steps:

Construction drawings for each sign type.

Get price quotes for each sign type.

Manufacture and install beginning with signs at Frautschi Point - Gateway sign and Kiosk.

Continue to work on design of other sign types, reminders such as “NO BIKES”, “BIKE ON RIGHT, WALK ON LEFT”, Temporary informational signs, regulatory signs.

Determine the program for interpretive signage, what, where and how many.
