1.	Project Location: Along wooded edges of the walking paths in the Preserve, preferably the Frautschi Path/Big Oak path area, or Tent ColonyFrautschi Point – clearing at intersection of main driveway and lakeshore path at sedge point.
2.	 <u>Project/Support Description</u>: Organize a volunteer planting day with Preserve staff. In collaboration with Preserve staff, develop a list of appropriate native, flowering plants and identify pathway segments to be planted. Purchase plant plugs (Preserve staff). Photograph the planting areas before and after the event from predetermined camera locations to track how the area changes. Invite volunteers from Eagle Heights Woods Project Stakeholder groups. Conclude the planting with a "spring tea party" recognizing volunteer efforts.
3.	<u>Project Planning</u>: This Friends project will augment 2012 and 2013 planting projects in this area by further improving the diversity of native, flowering woodland plants.
4.	Donation:Do you want to provide or donatefunds?\$750 for purchasing plants, and plants raised in greenhouse;volunteer assistance?_YES.
5.	<u>Volunteers:</u> Do you have volunteers that want to assist with field work? Friends volunteers and volunteers from Stakeholder groups. 15-20 people are likely to participate.
