In November we released three walks on our web site: Picnic Point to the Second Oak, with additional stops at Picnic Point Marsh and Biocore Prairie; Frautschi Point to Raymer's Cove, with stops at 2019 Friends Planting Area and Research and Community Gardens; and Raymer's Cove to Eagle Heights Woods, with an additional stop at Wally Bauman Woods.
